Travel tips

There are a number of ways to get to Dresden (all more or less equally interesting ..!).

The only **direct flight** to Dresden from London is with CityJet from CityAirport: <u>http://www.cityjet.com/</u>. From the airport, there's a tram to Dresden Hauptbahnhof (the main rail station).

Other airlines offer **connecting flights** from a range of places (e.g. Lufthansa, BA, etc.)

It's also possible to fly to Berlin:

- flight to Berlin Tegel; then the bus to the main rail station (i.e. the Hauptbahnhof), then the train to Dresden (Eurocity, every two hours starting from 08:46, takes 2:15 and €40 one way)
- flight to Berlin Schönefeld; then direct Buses to Dresden:
